DRESS GUIDELINES

CNW RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASK ANYONE TO CHANGE HIS/HER OUTFIT.

GUYS: Loose fitting shorts or jeans may be worn for recreation and chapel services. Casual pants and collared shirts are preferred for evening services. No Tank tops or cut off are allowed.

GIRLS: All attire must be loose fitting and close to knee length. Tank tops, low necklines, & tight-fitting clothing are not acceptable camp attire. Modest skirts or dresses are preferred for evening services. Swimsuits should be one-piece or tankini.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- A nurse is on site during the camp week.
- Certified lifeguards supervise all waterfront activities.
- Over-the-counter medications can only be distributed by the camp nurse and staff. The camp nurse has non-prescription medicines in the event of minor illness or injury.
- Please do not send medication or vitamins with campers unless they are prescribed by a doctor.
- All medications MUST be in their original, labeled containers in a Ziploc bag with any additional instructions.

PARENTS

- During the camp week, use of camp or personal phones by campers is prohibited.
- In case of an emergency camp staff will contact you.
- Arrival/departure info should be coordinated with your group sponsor. Only items that seem of value will be kept for two weeks following the week of camp.
- Requested items can be mailed at your expense.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers must be 16 years old for Junior Week and 18 years old for Senior Week. All applications must be submitted by March 1st. When staff positions are full, applicants desiring to work at camp will be charged \$125.
